ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 1, 2020, recommendation regarding administrative completeness and proposed notice of the above-styled and numbered application.

The administrative law judge finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before August 3, 2020, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the July 1, 2020 memorandum of Patricia Garcia. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before September 3, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
