COMMISSION STAFF'S FOURTH UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Fourth Unopposed Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On June 3, 2020, the City of Pflugerville (Pflugerville) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) number 11303 under Texas Water Code § 13.255 in order to incorporate areas it currently serves and decertify a portion of Manville Water Supply Corporation's (Manville) water service area in Travis County. The requested service area consists of 2,698.11 acres.

On August 13, 2020, Staff filed its third unopposed request for extension, which was subsequently granted by Order No. 4, issued by the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) on the same day. Order No. 4 required Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and propose a procedural schedule by September 4, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. On August 25, 2020, Pflugerville provided Staff with supplemental mapping information necessary for Staff to make a determination regarding the administrative completeness of the application and notice. On August

31, 2020, Pflugerville filed the supplemental mapping information and an executed agreement between the parties reflecting the information provided and discussed. Staff requires additional time to review the supplemental agreement and mapping material.

As such, Staff requests that its deadline to file a recommendation be extended to October 12, 2020 so that Staff may review the submitted agreement and mapping material. Staff has conferred with counsel for Pflugerville and Manville, and neither party is opposed to the requested extension.

III. CONCLUSION

On the aforementioned basis, Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ extend the deadline to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness and proposed notice to October 12, 2020.
