**ORDER NO. 6
FINDING APPLICATION COMPLETE; REQUIRING NOTICE; AND
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES**

This Order addresses the application of the City of Pflugerville filed on June 3, 2020, to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 11303 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.255 and to decertify a portion of Manville Water Supply Corporation's water service area in Travis County. On August 31 and October 23, 2020, Pflugerville filed supplements to the application. On December 18, 2020, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Pflugerville to provide notice of the application as described in the December 18, 2020 memorandum of Jolie Mathis, using the forms attached to Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed notice.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Staff to provide notice forms to Pflugerville	December 31, 2020
Deadline for Pflugerville to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was provided and published in a newspaper of general circulation, along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties	January 21, 2021
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a supplemental procedural schedule	January 28, 2021
Deadline to intervene	Thirty (30) days after notice is issued
