**COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Second Unopposed Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On June 3, 2020, the City of Pflugerville (Pflugerville) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) number 11303 under Texas Water Code § 13.255 in order to incorporate areas it currently serves and decertify a portion of Manville Water Supply Corporation's (Manville) water service area in Travis County. The requested service area consists of 2,698.11 acres.

On June 5, 2020, Order No. 1 was issued establishing a deadline of July 6, 2020 for Staff to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and notice and propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the application.

On July 2, 2020 Staff filed an unopposed request for extension of time to allow Pflugerville and Manville to file supplemental documentation supporting the application. On July 6, 2020, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 2, granting Staff's request for an extension of time and requiring Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and propose a procedural schedule by July 16, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

## **II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff has continued to communicate with both Applicants to determine the appropriate way to handle certification in the areas where Manville will serve legacy customers.

As such, Pflugerville and Manville require additional time to file supplemental documentation supporting the application. Staff requests that its deadline to file a recommendation be extended to August 15, 2020 so that Pflugerville and Manville may file supplemental information as required, and Staff may review same. Staff has conferred with counsel for Pflugerville and Manville, and neither party is opposed to the requested extension.

## **III. CONCLUSION**

On the aforementioned basis, Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ extend the deadline to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness and proposed notice to August 15, 2020.
