ORDER NO. 2 FINDING PETITION INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the petition filed on June 8, 2020, by the Estate of David A. Wetz, deceased, to amend Green Valley Special Utility District's sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Guadalupe County by streamlined expedited release. On July 8, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness.

The administrative law judge finds the petition is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review.

By August 7, 2020, the applicant must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies described in Jolie Mathis' July 8, 2020, memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the petition cannot proceed.

By September 7, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
