ORDER NO. 3 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT; ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the June 8, 2020, petition of the Estate of David A. Wetz, deceased, to amend Green Valley Special Utility District's sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Guadalupe County by streamlined expedited release, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(*l*). On June 16 and July 23 and 28, 2020, petitioner filed supplements to the petition.

On September 8, 2020, Commission Staff recommended that the petition be found administratively complete and notice be found sufficient. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete and notice sufficient.

Under the provisions of TWC § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, if streamlined expedited release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
