**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,  
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of the City of Mesquite and Talty Special Utility District filed on June 15, 2020 for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248, and to amend certificate of convenience and necessity number 10850 in Kaufman County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By January 13, 2021, Mesquite and Talty SUD must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Jolie Mathis' December 14, 2020 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed.

By February 12, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
