COMMISSION STAFF'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION

On June 15, 2020, the City of Mesquite (Mesquite) and Talty Special Utility District (Talty SUD) (collectively, Petitioners) filed a petition for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.248 and to amend water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Kaufman County. The Petitioners seek to amend Mesquite's water CCN number 10060 to add approximately 131 acres in Kaufman County and contains 23 customer connections from Talty's CCN water CCN number 10850.

On February 17, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, establishing a deadline of April 23, 2021 for Staff to request a hearing, or file a final recommendation, if no hearing is requested. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

Staff has reviewed the petition and supplemental filings and, as detailed in the attached memorandum of Jolie Mathis of the Infrastructure Division, recommends that the petition be approved. Staff further recommends that the Petitioners file certified copies of the attached CCN map, along with a written description of the CCN service area in the Kaufman County Clerk's office, as required by TWC § 13.257(r) and (s). Staff has attached copies of the final map and certificates consented to by the Petitioners to this final recommendation.

II. CONCLUSION

On the above basis, Staff respectfully recommends approval of the petition and requests that an order be filed consistent with this recommendation.

On June 15, 2020, the City of Mesquite (Mesquite) and Talty Special Utility District (Talty SUD) (collectively, Petitioners) filed a petition for approval of a contract designating Certificate Convenience and Necessity (CCN) service areas under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.248. Specifically, Petitioners seek to amend Mesquite's water CCN No. 10060 and Talty SUD's CCN No. 10850 in Kaufman County, Texas. The Petitioners' TWC § 13.248 service area contract is being reviewed in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.253.

The Petitioners filed an agreement requesting Talty SUD be permitted to transfer a portion of its water service area under CCN No. 10850 Mesquite's CCN No. 10060. Specifically, Mesquite and Talty SUD entered into a contractual agreement which permits Mesquite to provide water services within the agreed upon water service area. The Petitioners will transfer assets and facilities under the terms of the agreement. The water service area the Petitioners contracted to transfer consists of approximately 131 acres and 23 customers.

Notice was provided to the affected customers in the area subject to the transfer. The customers are currently provided service by Talty SUD. No assets or facilities are being transferred under the terms of the agreement. The Petitioners submitted documentation to satisfy the notice requirements under 16 TAC § 24.253(c).

The petition meets all applicable requirements of TWC, Chapter 13 and 16 TAC, Chapter 24. Therefore, I recommend approval of the petition.

The Petitioners consented to the attached map and certificates on March 30, 2021 and April 1, 2021.


