**ORDER NO. 3
CLARIFYING AND MODIFYING ORDER NO. 2**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 3, 2020 request to clarify Order No. 2 regarding the need for Trent Water Works, LLC to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff.

In Order No. 2 filed on August 12, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the application administratively incomplete and directed Trent Water Works to, no later than September 13, 2020, cure the deficiencies as described in the July 16, 2020 memorandum of Heidi Graham. Due to an oversight, the order did not mention the need to cure the deficiencies described in the memorandum of Maxine Gilford, also dated July 16, 2020. Commission Staff requested clarification of this point. Additionally, the ALJ notes that September 13, 2020 falls on a Sunday.

The ALJ clarifies that Trent Water Works must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the July 16, 2020 memoranda of both Heidi Graham and Maxine Gilford. Due to the additional requirement imposed by this Order, the ALJ extends Trent Water Works' deadline to supplement the application to cure the deficiencies.


On or before September 23, 2020, Trent Water Works must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the July 16, 2020 memoranda of Heidi Graham and Maxine Gilford.

On or before October 21, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule for further processing, if appropriate.
