The proposed rates will apply to service received after the effective date provided below, unless modified or suspended by the Commission. If the Commission receives a sufficient number of protests, separately or in a combined protest letter, from at least 2,946 ratepayers (10 percent of the utility's customers over whose rates the Commission has original jurisdiction) or from any affected municipality before the 91st day after the proposed effective date, the matter will be set for hearing. ### **EFFECTIVE DATE OF PROPOSED INCREASE:** August 19, 2020

The main reason for the proposed rate change is to recover capital investments of over \$35.1 million Monarch has spent over the past four-and-a-half years to maintain and improve its systems in order to provide quality water and wastewater service to customers.

RE: Protest Monarch Utilities L.P. Rates

We are writing today to protest the rates of Monarch Utilites and their proposed Rate Increase...

We purchased a home in December, 2019 in Bandera County..and moved permanent to this area by January, 2020. Much to our surprise to find that Monarch Utiities charge MONTHLY fees to their customers just for being a customer not even counting costs of the water used. Not many places we know of charge people to just be a customer. We are paying \$49.30 monthly fees to Monarch, and additional for the actual water used since we moved here. Thus for we elderly people, our water bill runs over \$80 a month. We moved here from Leon County...NEVER had to pay to be their customer, merely paid for the water used. Our bill ran at a normal rate of around \$25-\$30 month. Now, Monarch is wanting to increase that rate to \$54.15 per month plus the water used. I'm not sure what exactly happened to this part of the world, but County taxes are outlandish, property valuations outlandish...even Farm Bureau advises to pay Membership here in the Hill Country is \$10 higher than Central Texas and we only have Life Insurance through them.

It is our opinion that perhaps they should rethink their charge increase...Paying to just get the privilege to be a customer is ridiculious. We retired living on Social Security perhaps should get an "Over 65 or Homestead" consideration like the County Tax Office gives us...It is our opinion, Reflect price/Cost of water, but don't agree with these "hand me money if you want the privilege to pay for water through us"...
