Kurt Johnson, Rate Payer Comments:

Members of the Commission.

We spend the majority of our time (5 days a week) at our primary residence in Richardson, TX. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> home at 512 Turner Dr. in Trinidad is only used on the weekends. We use far more water each month in Richardson, yet my average water bill from Monarch is 10% higher than the bill from the City of Richardson.

How is this possible?

Monarch utility rates are already nearly double the rates of West Cedar Creek Municipal Utility District which serves the majority of homeowners on the west side of Cedar Creek Lake and many of our neighboring subdivisions.

If it is not possible for Monarch to earn a reasonable profit on their investment and still remain somewhat competitive with other area utilities, it seems only logical they should be caused to negotiate a reasonable sale to the local MUD with a much larger customer base. I am sure WCCMUD would be a willing participant.

The PUC is doing a disservice to the tax paying community be allowing Monarch to gouge rate payers just because they creatively justify rates. I understand capital and operating costs are real, and the customer base is insufficient to spread costs out to many households, but at what point is too much too much? Our community would best be served if Monarch would transfer water rights to WCCMUD whose utilities parallel Monarch's in many areas.

Please help us to end the monopoly now. Thank you for your time.
