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

MONARCH'S AMENDED RESPONSE TO OPUC'S FIRST RFI

OPUC 1-4 Please reference the Direct Testimony of Jeffrey L. McIntyre at 24:9 11. Please provide all documentation, workpapers, and any analysis performed or prepared by Monarch supporting the statement, "Since the last test year, operating expenses have increased by a compound annual growth rate in line with the consumer price index."

AMENDED RESPONSE:

While reviewing the RFIs and responses, I noticed the response should have "the compound annual rate is a negative (-) 0.5 percent," instead of negative (-) 5 percent. The amended response is below:

As shown on Attachment OPUC 1-4, Monarch's operating expenses increased by a compound annual rate of 1.6 percent, excluding the effects of normalizing and known & measurable adjustments. This rate is in line with the Consumer Price Index for South Urban BLS, which was 1.4 percent. However, when expressed on an operating-expense-per-meter-equivalent basis, the compound annual rate is a negative (-) **0.5** percent, indicating that Monarch has actually decreased its operating expense per connection since its last general rate case.

OPUC 1-21 Please reference the Direct Testimony of Edward Taussig at 6 7. Please provide a monthly detailed listing of all employees, by filled position, from January 2018, through November 2020.

AMENDED RESPONSE:

See *Confidential* Attachment OPUC 1-21, being filed under seal. The Direct Testimony of Edward Taussig on page 5 indicates Texas Utilities reorganized on January 1st, 2019. As a result, employees shifted into the new cost centers to begin the test year. In order to be consistent across the 3 years (2018-2020), the 2018 monthly worksheets in confidential attachment OPUC 1-21, have the actual (on board) employees in these new Monarch cost centers.

Additionally, Monarch identified and funded 18 positions in the 2018 and 2019 operating budgets required to increase business service levels supporting increased capital investment and previous customer growth in the 34 counties the company serves. This is consistent with the higher percentage of openings during 2018 and 2019 versus the current year.

Positions in *Confidential* Attachment OPUC 1-21 are listed in both the "Total" headcount section in columns (a)-(g) and "Actual" headcount section in columns (h)-(m). Because employees can change roles the Position description in column (m) can vary over the 2018-2020 time frame.
