**ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING  
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of the City of Dripping Springs to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity in Hays County.

The administrative law judge finds the supplemented application administratively complete and directs Dripping Springs to provide notice of the application as described in the October 2, 2020 memorandum of Jolie Mathis. Dripping Springs is required to provide notice using the forms attached to Commission Staff's recommendation dated October 2, 2020.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Event	Date
Deadline for applicant to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	November 18, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a supplemental procedural schedule	December 2, 2020
Deadline to intervene	Thirty (30) days after notice is issued
