ORDER NO. 4 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice of the application filed on June 18, 2020 by the City of Dripping Springs to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity in Hays County. On December 2, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.

Dripping Springs filed proof of notice documentation on November 18, 2020. Dripping Springs filed an affidavit of notice to neighboring utilities and affected parties indicating that notice of the application was mailed to those entities on October 27, 2020. Dripping Springs' filing also included a publisher's affidavit showing that notice was published in *Dripping Springs Century News*, a newspaper of general circulation in Hays County, on October 29, 2020, and November 3, and 12, 2020.

The administrative law judge finds notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing:

¹ Under 16 TAC § 24 235(a)(3), the intervention deadline is 30 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. Notice was mailed on October 27, 2020 and published on October 29, 2020 and November 5 and 12, 2020. Therefore, 30 days after November 12, 2020 is December 12, 2020. Because the Commission is not open for business on December 12, 2020, the deadline is December 14, 2020 under 16 TAC § 22.4(a).

| Deadline for Dripping Springs to file signed consent forms with the Commission | February 26, 2021 |
| If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application | March 5, 2021 |
| If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law | March 12, 2021 |
