**ORDER NO. 11  
GRANTING EXTENSION**

This Order addresses Undine Texas, LLC's October 27, 2021 request for an extension to complete their transaction. Undine states that the parties continue to work towards resolving all of the issues identified during the due diligence on the systems, and that resolution of those issues is necessary in order for the parties to close the transaction. Undine represents that Commission Staff does not object to the request for extension.

The administrative law judge grants Undine's request for extension. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(m), the deadline for the parties to complete their transaction is extended to January 7, 2022.

In an effort to finalize this case as soon as possible, the applicants must continue to file monthly updates regarding the status of closing and submit documents evidencing that the transaction was consummated.
