## COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND PROPOSED NOTICE

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Supplemental Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Notice. Staff recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete. In support, Staff shows the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On June 19, 2020, Nerro Supply, LLC (Nerro) and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC (Undine) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale and transfer of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) rights in Chambers, Harris, and Liberty Counties. Undine, CCN No. 20816, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of Nerro's sewer CCN No. 20366, cancel CCN No. 20366, decertify a portion of Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority's sewer CCN No. 20465, and add additional area to adjust CCN boundaries to properly cover the existing customers. The total area to be added to Undine's CCN No. 20816 is 344 acres and includes current customers. Applicants filed supplemental information on July 1, July 6, August 19, and August 20, 2020.

On July 23, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 2, which established a deadline of September 18, 2020 for Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

## II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

As detailed in the attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia of the Commission's Infrastructure Division, Staff has reviewed the application, along with the supplemental information provided, and recommends that it be found administratively complete.

#### III. PROPOSED NOTICE

The Commission's notice requirements for sale, transfer, merger applications are provided by 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239. Specifically, Staff recommends that Applicants be ordered to provide notice according to the attached memorandum of Ms. Garcia using the notices attached to this pleading. Along with each individual notice, Staff recommends that Applicants provide an accurate map delineating the requested service area.

Staff also recommends that Applicants publish notice once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the counties where the uncertificated requested area is located. Within 30 days of the provision of notice, Staff recommends that Applicants file proof of notice, including a copy of the map provided, as described in the attached memorandum and proof of newspaper publication, including tear sheets. Finally, it is recommended that Applicants use the attached affidavits to meet these requirements.

## IV. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule for the continued processing of this application:

Deadline for Applicants to file proof of notice, including signed affidavits that notice was provided along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	November 2, 2020
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	November 12, 2020
Deadline to file a motion to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

# V. REQUEST TO RESTYLE DOCKET

Staff respectfully requests that the docket be restyled to "Application of Nerro Supply, LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC for Sale, Transfer or Merger of Facilities and Certificate

*Rights in Chambers, Harris, and Liberty Counties.*" This change properly reflects the counties in which the transaction contemplated in this docket will take place.

# VI. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that the application be deemed administratively complete and that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted for further processing of the application.

On June 19, 2020, Undine Texas Environmental, LLC (Undine or Purchaser) and Nerro Supply, LLC (Nerro or Seller) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for Sale, Transfer, or Merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in Chambers, Harris, and Liberty Counties, Texas, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239. Additionally, Undine is seeking to add additional area and decertify a portion of Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority's sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20465 in Chambers and Harris Counties, Texas pursuant to TWC §§ 13.242 to 13.250 and 16 TAC §§ 24.225 to 24.237.

Specifically, Undine, sewer CCN No. 20816, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer the remaining portion of Nerro's sewer CCN No. 20366, cancel CCN No. 20366,<sup>1</sup> and decertify a portion of Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority's (Gulf Coast) sewer CCN No. 20465. Undine is also requesting adjustments to the CCN area to adjust borders to properly cover the customers served in the areas. The total area to be transferred from Nerro is approximately 111 acres; 32 of these acres are incorrectly reflected on Nerro's current sewer CCN map and need to be moved to the correct location. The total area to be certificated to Undine is 344 acres. This is comprised of 111 acres transferred from Nerro (including the 32-acre piece mentioned above that is incorrectly reflected on Nerro's current sewer CCN map and needs to be moved to the correct location), 218 acres decertified from Gulf Coast, and 47 acres previously uncertificated.

Staff from the Rate Regulation Division and Infrastructure Division have reviewed the additional information filed by the Applicants on August 19 and 20, 2020 and recommend that the application be deemed administratively complete. Staff further recommends that the Applicants be ordered to do the following:

- 1) Provide notice of the application by first-class mail to the following:
  - a. Cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area:

e. Any affected customers, and other affected parties in the requested area.

Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's (TCEQ) web site located at <u>http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/</u>.

- 2) Publish notice in a newspaper having general circulation in each county where the uncertificated requested area is located, once each week for two consecutive weeks. Proof in the form of a publisher's affidavit must be filed within 30 days of the publication date. The affidavit must state with specificity each county in which the newspaper is of general circulation. Within 30 days of the date the notice was mailed, the Applicants must file an affidavit specifying the notice that was provided to every person and entity to whom notice was provided and the date the notice was mailed.
- 3) Provide notice using the attached notice forms.
- 4) Provide a copy of a map delineating the requested area with each individual notice to neighboring utilities, other affected parties, landowners and customers.
- 5) File in the docket a map and copy of notice along with the signed affidavit specifying every person and entity to whom notice was provided, the date that the notice was provided, and the publisher's affidavit and tear sheets for proof of newspaper publication.

Staff may determine that additional information is needed to make a final recommendation in this docket. If additional information is needed, Staff may send requests for information (RFI) to the Applicants. The Applicants will have 20 days from the receipt of the RFI to respond.

An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a large-scale map, a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land, landowner's name, address, email address and fax number, if applicable.
