**ORDER NO. 5  
 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Nerro Supply, LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC. On November 17 and 18, 2020, applicants filed proof, partially under confidential seal, that notice was provided to current customers, neighboring systems, and cities, and other affected parties on October 12, 2020; and published in the *Houston Business Journal*, a newspaper of general circulation in Chambers, Harris, and Liberty counties on October 16 and 23, 2020. On November 23, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing:

Deadline to intervene	November 23, 2020 <sup>1</sup>
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment	December 22, 2020
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale	January 6, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed.	January 21, 2021
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	February 22, 2021 <sup>2</sup>

<sup>1</sup> The 30-day deadline from October 23, 2020 is Sunday, November 22, 2020; therefore, under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(a), the deadline moves to the next day the Commission is open for business, or Monday, November 23, 2020.

<sup>2</sup> The 120-day deadline from October 23, 2020 is Saturday, February 20, 2021; therefore under 16 TAC § 22.4(a), the deadline moves to the next day the Commission is open for business, or Monday, February 22, 2021.
