COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Request for Extension. In support, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On June 19, 2020, Nerro Supply, LLC (Nerro) and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC (Undine) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale and transfer of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) rights in Chambers, Harris, and Liberty Counties. Undine, sewer CCN No. 20816, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of Nerro's service area under sewer CCN No. 20366, cancel CCN No. 20366, decertify a portion of Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority's sewer CCN No. 20465, and add additional area to adjust CCN boundaries to properly cover the existing customers. =

On November 23, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, which established a deadline of January 21, 2021 for the parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. The parties are working to finalize the joint proposed order. Therefore, Staff requests an extension of the deadline to file the joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline for the joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and transaction to proceed be extended to January 29, 2021.
