## ORDER NO. 5 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Nerro Supply, LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC. On November 30, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the notice provided.

Nerro and Undine filed proof of notice on November 18, 2020. The applicants filed an affidavit attesting that notice was provided to current customers, neighboring systems, and cities, and other affected parties on October 12, 2020. Further, the applicants also filed a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in the *Houston Business Journal*, a newspaper of general circulation in Chambers, Harris, and Liberty counties on October 16 and 23, 2020.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing:

Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment	December 23, 2020
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale	January 6, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed.	January 20, 2021
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	February 22, 2021 <sup>2</sup>
