ORDER NO. 7 GRANTING EXTENSION AND REVISING DEADLINES

This Order addresses the City of McGregor's February 5, 2021 request to extend the deadlines to cure deficiencies and for Commission Staff to file a second supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application along with a proposed procedural schedule. The City of McGregor represents that Commission Staff is unopposed to the request for extension.

The administrative law judge grants the City of McGregor's request for extension. By March 5, 2021 the City of McGregor must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in the memorandum of Jolie Mathis, dated October 5, 2020, attached to Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before April 9, 2021, Commission Staff must file a second supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
