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APPLICATION OF THE CITY OF MCGREGOR TO AMEND CERTIFICATES OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AND FOR DUAL CERTIFICATION WITH THE CITY OF WACO IN MCLENNAN COUNTY

COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On June 22, 2020, City of McGregor (City) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) Nos. 10033 and 20009 and for dual certification with the City of Waco CCN Nos. 10039 and 20010 in McClennan County, Texas. The requested service area consists of 23 acres and 47 proposed connections to a phase I development within the City of McGregor's corporate limits and within the water and sewer CCN boundaries of the City of Waco. The City of McGregor also seeks dual certification with the City of Waco for the requested area. The City filed supplements to the application on July 10, 2020, August 12, 2020, August 25, November 5, 2020.

On November 9, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 12, establishing a deadline of December 6, 2021 for the City to file supplementary information, and a deadline of January 5, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and propose a procedural schedule. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. To date, the City has not filed the supplemental information required by Order No. 12. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order requiring the City to file supplementary information by February 7, 2022, and extending the deadline for Staff to file supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and propose a procedural schedule to March 7, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request.
