**ORDER NO. 4
GRANTING ABATEMENT**

This Order addresses the application of James Nelson dba Waterco and Commission Staff's request for abatement filed on November 17, 2020.

As a result of the discussion that occurred at the October 16, 2020 open meeting, Commission Staff moves to abate this proceeding. Given that Waterco has stated its agreement to work with Commission Staff to come into compliance with applicable rules and laws, Commission Staff recommends that abating the present procedural schedule will best enable Commission Staff and Waterco to reach a productive outcome. As a first step, Waterco will receive assistance with its certificate of convenience and necessity application from the Texas Rural Water Association.

The administrative law judge grants the abatement and this proceeding is abated. A status report by the parties must be filed and if appropriate, a proposed procedural schedule by February 9, 2021.
