


RE: FRAUDULENT INFORMATION PROVIDED IN WATERCO CCN APPLICATION

Mr. McMurray,

This information is provided in protest to the CCN application, which appears to be once again an "exempt application" by James Nelson, owner of Waterco, public water service provider for Nocona Lake Estates in Montague County, Texas.

James Nelson provides once again false information regarding the number of connections.




The resident at 140 Keck Street has a court date on July 8, 2020 with James Nelson for an eviction notice. This is Nelson's rent-to-own property as well as the location of the Keck Street well. This eviction process is similar to the actions Art and Becky Bolduc experienced once

they sale of the Keck Street Well was considered void due to Nelson did not transfer the title of the well to the Bolduc in the sale process. See Dockets #48039 and 48040.

Ray and Margie Debore's connection has been removed from this list. They are a rent-to-own property of Nelson's at 142 Walnut Street which Gloria Moore has reported there is no well on this property. Ray is known to do whatever Nelson asks of him. Ray is financially tied to Nelson with this property.

Once again, Nelson manipulates the number of connections as he see fits - or as some say - the number of Nelson's connections depends on which way the wind is blowing that day.

Here in Nelson's own handwriting he describes not reporting Vern Malone's connection to TCEQ and yet here on this list we find Vern Malone appearing again.




This document is a note to his attorney and has been provided by Gloria Moore.

You will also see 222 Walnut Street connection. I spoke to the heirs of this estate. There are two connections with these people. The daughter continues to maintain this connection and the house next door. These people know nothing of what is going on with Waterco. Nelson himself shows these connections in a map he created. These connections are shown in Map 1 however are deleted in Map 2.

MAP 2




Mr. Nelson also states he has not had any requests for water service. This is somewhat false. Waterco does have a connection at 178 Oak Street. I spoke with Mr. Parson's on 12.9.2019, and he mentioned Nelson refused to provide him with service in order to keep the water


connections low. I reported this to TCEQ on 12.9.2010. Parsons has made it known to me, he wants my property and or water from my property in order to not do business with Nelson.

Nocona Lake Estates has many opportunities to bring in new residents. Several lots and homes are up for sale. As long as this problem with WATERCO hangs over Nocona Lake Estates, our community will not be able to grow due to not having proper infrastructure in place for growth.

Nelson check the box regarding any enforcement action by the Commission, TCEQ, Texas Department of Health or the Office of the Attorney General, or the Environmental Protection Agency in the past 5 years. However, Nelson failed to provide any attachments regarding these complaints.



Here is information from TCEQ on the Status of WATERCO.




You will see TCEQ recognizes 20 connections. No buyer at this time for Waterco. Should you click on the links for violations and enforcements you will find many violations for failure to monitor the water properly, failure to notify the consumers and public about the BOIL WATER NOTICE. TCEQ representatives had to come out personally and hand the BWN's out. You will also find Total Coliform was found in the Keck Street Well water.


Here is the current enforcement action: It is my understanding the TCEQ enforcement action is in litigation. The Settlement Offer was terminated due to Nelson's inaction towards meeting the expectations of TCEQ.



Here is the case number for the Total Coliform issue with the Keck Street well. It is my understanding this case has been submitted to the EPA.



This portion of the application is laughable knowing the Total Coliform in the Keck Street well and the numerous violations and the make shift septic construction which has caused the Total Coliform problem on Keck Street. At this point, it is clear Nelson will never take responsibility for properly providing Nocona Lake Estates with a water service incompliance with the State of Texas.



Nelson did submit an application for EXEMPT STATUS in the Docket #47411. However, he was instructed to submit in a separate docket which resulted in Docket #48039 and 48040. These applications were WITHDRAWN by Nelson and Bolduc.

I could go on further about the discrepancies in this application however, I know for a fact there has been sufficient investigation by TCEQ to dispute the number of connections reported here in this application.

At this time, I request from PUC of Texas Staff to "lean in" and find a way forward for Nocona Lake Estates in Montague County, Texas. Nelson has proven he will go to great lengths to avoid bringing his water service to the standards set forth by the State of Texas. Waterco has had 3 years to make an honest attempt at applying for a CCN, and yet he chooses not to. This is not acceptable. Expecting the community of Nocona Lake Estates to endure this type of non-management of WATERCO is inhumane.

At this time, I request a CEASE & DESIST on any further delay tactics by WATERCO owner, James Nelson. It is time for PUC to step up and hold WATERCO owner James Nelson, accountable for not operating incompliance with the PUC of TEXAS and for submitting inadequate applications, for complete disregard of the PUC Commission staff request in Docket 49532, and for submitting fraudulent information regarding the number of connection again.
