ADDRESSING MOTION TO DISMISS**


This Order addresses the application of James Nelson dba Waterco to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montague County.

On April 14, 2020, Commission Staff filed a status report and motion to dismiss contending that the application should be dismissed as moot under 16 TAC § 22.181(d)(2). In Docket No. 51642, CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC purchased all of Waterco's utility assets.<sup>1</sup> The transaction has been consummated and approved in Docket No. 51642, and therefore Waterco no longer is in possession of any utility assets for which to apply for a water CCN.<sup>2</sup>

Waterco may respond to this motion to dismiss by May 20, 2022, or in the alternative withdraw the application.
