## ORDER NO. 11 ADDRESSING MOTION TO DISMISS

This Order addresses the application of James Nelson dba Waterco to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montague County.

On April 14, 2020, Commission Staff filed a status report and motion to dismiss contending that the application should be dismissed as moot under 16 TAC § 22.181(d)(2). In Docket No. 51642, CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC purchased all of Waterco's utility assets. The transaction has been consummated and approved in Docket No. 51642, and therefore Waterco no longer is in possession of any utility assets for which to apply for a water CCN.

Waterco may respond to this motion to dismiss by May 20, 2022, or in the alternative withdraw the application.
