ORDER DIRECTING ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS

This order addresses the sale, transfer, merger (STM) applications involving CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC filed with the Commission from November 18, 2019 through August 6, 2020; specifically Docket Nos. 50276, 50311, 50989, 51003, 51026, 51031, 51036, 51047, 51065, 51089, 51118, 51126, 51130, and 51146. Commission Staff has identified concerns regarding processing this large number of applications, including concerns regarding maintaining the accuracy of the maps as Commission Staff reviews the applications. The administrative law judge (ALJ) agrees that the simultaneous processing of multiple STM applications involving CSWR has the potential to create logistical hurdles and confusion as to the proper analysis and facts to be applied when evaluating each application. In order to reduce, in part, the possibility of confusion, all of the above cases have been reassigned to the undersigned ALJ.

The ALJ is of the opinion that these applications are inextricably intertwined with one another, such that the analysis in each subsequent application requires consideration of the ones that preceded it. For example, in Docket No. 50251, CSWR plans to purchase from JRM Water LLC a water system that serves 438 acres and 211 customers in Victoria County. When Commission Staff formulated its recommendation as to whether the transaction in Docket No. 50251 should be allowed to proceed, it analyzed and applied the relevant legal factors to determine whether CSWR has the wherewithal to serve a water system of 438 acres and 211 customers in Victoria County.

The ALJ believes that, when Commission Staff formulates its recommendations in each subsequent CSWR STM case, it should do in a cumulative manner; that is, by also considering the recommendations it has already made in any prior cases. In Docket No. 50276, CSWR plans to purchase from North Victoria Utilities, Inc. a water system that serves 307 acres and 77 customers in Victoria County. Thus, assuming that Docket No. 50276 is the next case in which Commission Staff formulates its recommendation as to whether the transaction in should be allowed to proceed, Commission Staff should analyze whether CSWR has the wherewithal to serve:

Docket Nos. 50276, 50311, 50989, 51003, 51026, 51031, 51036, 51047, 51065, 51089, 51118, 51126, 51130, and 51146

- a water system of 307 acres and 77 customers in Victoria County (i.e., the water system being purchased in Docket No. 50276); *plus*
- a water system of 438 acres and 211 customers in Victoria County (i.e., the water system being purchased in Docket No. 50251).

Using this approach, each subsequent Commission Staff recommendation will take into account all prior cases in which Staff is recommending that the transaction should be allowed to proceed. By the time Commission Staff considers the last of the 15 applications, Commission Staff will be formulating its recommendation as to whether the transaction should be allowed to proceed by analyzing whether CSWR has the wherewithal to serve all of the systems being acquired in all 15 dockets.

The parties are ordered to process these cases in the manner described above.
