Dear Judge Moore:

On July 28, 2020 Staff (“Staff”) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas requested that its deadline for filing a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and proposed notice (“Recommendation”) be abated for 14 days after the first issuance of an Order Approving the Transaction to Proceed in Docket No. 50251, 50276, or 50311. An Order Approving the Transaction to Proceed was issued in Docket No. 50251 on August 3, 2020. Accordingly, abatement is no longer necessary.

Based on Order No. 2 in this proceeding, CSWR Texas understands that Staff’s Recommendation is due August 17, 2020, which is 14 days after the issuance of the order in Docket No. 50251, and that this proceeding may otherwise move forward at this time.
