**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the July 1, 2020 application of Richard Billings dba Billings Water Supply Company dba Oak Hill Ranch Estates Water Company and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Guadalupe and Wilson counties.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before September 2, 2020, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the August 17, 2020 memorandum of Jolie Mathis. The ALJ notes that the applicants have supplemented their application materials. The ALJ recognizes that some, if not all, of the deficiencies specified in August 10, 2020 memorandum of Jolie Mathis may be remedied. However, until the Commission receives and reviews all supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before September 14, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
