ORDER NO. 8 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

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This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice filed by CSWR-Texas. On December 18, 2020, CSWR-Texas filed an affidavit attesting to the provision of notice to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on December 3, 2020. CSWR-Texas also filed a copy of the notice and maps sent. Notice was published the *Seguin Gazette*, a newspaper of general circulation in Guadalupe County, on December 6, and 13, 2020, and in the *Wilson County News*, a newspaper of general circulation in Wilson County, on December 2 and 9, 2020. On December 31, 2020, Commission Staff recommended that the notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and the procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

Deadline to file a motion to intervene	January 12, 2021 ¹
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval on the sale and on the CCN amendment	February 11, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale	February 25, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	March 11, 2021

¹ Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(b), the intervention period must not be less than 30 days unless good cause is shown. Notice was mailed on December 3, 2020 and published on December 2, 6, 9, and 13, 2020. Thirty days after December 13, 2020 is January 12, 2021.
