It is generally understood among the parties that we discussed with that parties will not ask “friendly cross examination.” Further, we are not necessarily aware that all of the parties listed above intend to participate in the hearing, but attempted to be more broadly inclusive, in case parties do appear tomorrow that we have not heard from. Finally, at this time we are cautiously optimistic that the hearing can be accomplished within the timeframe of a reasonable hearing day tomorrow (e.g., 6 to 6.5 hours), but will be prepared to engage with the ALJs and the parties tomorrow to discuss time expectations at the start of the hearing if you prefer.
