STATEMENT OF POSITION OF

My name is Mark A. Siegel. I am an intervenor in this case. I live at 11430 Anaqua Springs, Boerne, TX, which is within the Anaqua Springs Ranch subdivision and am impacted by the transmission line that runs along Toutant Beauregard Rd. and that runs along the southern border of Anaqua Springs Ranch property.


I am opposed to the proposed routes that would use/ run along/ are parallel to/ follow Toutant Beauregard Rd. because such a line would inflict a severe negative impact on the esthetics of the area as well as a negative impact to the property values of residents. Toutant Beauregard Rd. is a two-lane, country road that is the primary thoroughfare for those who live and work in the historic Scenic Loop – Boerne Stage Corridor. There is no need to destroy the scenic beauty of Toutant Beauregard Rd when other routes/segments for the utility line towers have been identified by, and are available to, CPS Energy that impose less of an impact to the residents of the area.

I am also opposed to the routes that use segments 38, 39 and 43 because those segments impact Anaqua Springs properties on the southern border, for the same reasons stated above.
