## STATEMENT OF POSITION OF ADRIAN AND CATHERINE CHAVEZ

Our names are Adrian and Catherine Chavez. We are intervenors in this case. We live at 11202 Caliza Bluff, which is within the Anaqua Springs Ranch subdivision and are impacted by the transmission line routes that run along the southern border of Anaqua Sprints Ranch property and Toutant Beauregard Road.

We are opposed to route segments 38, 39, and 43 on the southern border of Anaqua Springs Ranch because we live directly along this route and have young children who live in the residence with us. This is our dream home that we built together, to meet the needs of our young family. We recently completed the development of a pool, so that we could enjoy time together in our back yard, as an extension of a safe haven for our family, particularly during this time of pandemic. Both of us work in the healthcare industry, and are deeply concerned about the long-term health implications that a transmission line would have on the development of our young girls and potential health impact on us, as well. Building the transmission line would impact the health of our young children and our family, of which we are both strongly opposed to.

We are also opposed to the routes that use/ run along/ are parallel to/ or follow Toutant Beauregard Road because this segment impacts Anaqua Springs Ranch properties.
