

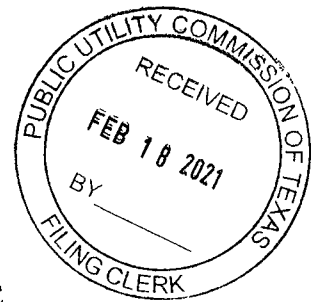

**STATEMENT OF POSITION OF
MICHELLE D. ALTEMOSE**

My name is Michelle Altemose. My husband, Greg Altemose, and I are intervenors in this case. I live at 11426 Anaqua Springs, Boerne TX, which is within the Anaqua Springs Ranch subdivision and am impacted by the transmission line that runs along Toutant Beauregard and that runs along the southern border of Anaqua Springs Ranch property.

I am opposed to the routes that use/ run along/are parallel to/ or follow Toutant Beauregard Road.

Obviously, the individuals planning to put these power lines right outside Anaqua Springs Ranch are not aware of why some families sought out a neighborhood like Anaqua Springs Ranch.

My husband Greg and I searched all over San Antonio and Boerne for a neighborhood that was beautiful and a healthier atmosphere for our children. We have saved our entire lives to live in a place like Anaqua Springs Ranch. If those power lines are allowed to be placed outside Anaqua Springs Ranch not only will we lose about 25-30 percent of our investment, but we will be putting our children's health at risk. We looked at 80 houses, flew in several trips to find our home.
