



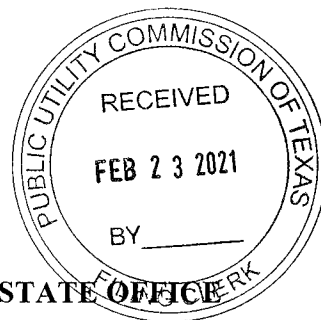



SOAH ORDER NO. 7  
REGARDING DEADLINES

Due to the recent inclement weather, many Texans were left without electricity and other services and the State Office of Administrative Hearings was closed the week of February 15-19, 2021. Pursuant to SOAH Order No. 6, the deadline for intervenors to file direct testimony or a statement of position had been set for February 17, 2021. A number of motions for extension of the deadline have been filed, citing weather-related disruptions. Further, intervenor Anaqua Springs Homeowners' Association indicated in a letter filed as Document No. 553 that the parties have an upcoming call to discuss amending deadlines. Recognizing the impact of the weather-related disruptions, the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) intend to issue an order extending the deadline for intervenors to file direct testimony or a statement of position. However, because moving that deadline affects other deadlines in place, the ALJs will wait for the parties to confer and propose agreed amendments to the procedural schedule in this case prior to ordering specific changes.
