## STATEMENT OF POSITION OF MARICELA SIEGEL

My name is Maricela Siegel. I am an intervenor in this case. I live at 11430 Anaqua Springs, Boerne, TX, which is within the Anaqua Springs Ranch subdivision and am impacted by the transmission line that runs along Toutant Beauregard Road and that runs along the southern border of Anaqua Springs Ranch property.

I am opposed to the routes that use/ run along/ are parallel to/ or follow Toutant Beauregard. The proposed route runs through the property of Dr. Sara B. McAndrew Elementary School, which is located at 26615 Toutant Beauregard Road, Boerne TX and comes within 300 feet of the school building and 150 feet of the playground. I am concerned about the potential impact of high voltage transmission lines on children who attend this school. High voltage transmission lines emit electromagnetic fields which have been linked to leukemia and negative effects on the neurobehavioral performance in children. While the effects of these transmission lines on developing children have not been conclusively proven, it is unconscionable that CPS would entertain such a route when other, less intrusive routes are available. Further, as part of their dual campus model. Northside Independent School District has proposed a middle school on Toutant Beauregard in close proximity to McAndrew Elementary School, which would also be impacted

by this proposed route and its high voltage transmission lines. We urge you not to put the desires

of wealthy land developers, who are willing to donate land to CPS in order to get their way, ahead

of the safety of our community's school children.

The proposed route would also inflict a severe negative impact on the natural beauty of this

area, which is what originally drew us to it to purchase our dream home. Estimates indicate that

property values could be cut by 20-40% by locating 130-foot transmission towers with high

voltage electrical lines in such close proximity to homes along Toutant Beauregard Rd. It is

completely unjustified for CPS to construct transmission towers so close to the many existing

homes and families that have been here for years rather than on available undeveloped land:

thereby protecting the interests of land developers who hope to develop future housing projects

while putting those who have already live here at risk. CPS is demonstrating complete disregard

for individual homeowners' interests.

I am also opposed to the routes that use segments 38, 39, and 43 because those segments

impact Anaqua Springs properties on the southern border.

I wish to remain an intervenor and participate in this case.
