Reply to Raul Figueroa Exceptions to the Proposal for Decision

- 1. I, Stephen V. Rockwood, part owner of several parcels of land and a house in northwest Bexar County including 4 lots at High Country Ranch Association (HCR) and several other parcels surrounding HCR and having previously submitted testimony in regards Docket No. 51023, respectfully disagree with Raul Figueroa that Route AA-1 is a more favorable route than Z-2. Although our home is closer to route Z-2, Z-2 is better than Route AA-1. I would also state that both routes AA-1 and Z-2 would deter and disrupt the recreational and aesthetic values of High Country Ranch.
- **2.** As previously stated in earlier testimony and based on PURA 37.056 and the Environmental Assessment and Alternative Route Analysis, there are several alternative routes to AA-1 that encounter fewer habitual structures such as routes P, Q1, N1, and R1.
- **3.** I stand firm in my belief that these are the routes that the PUC should be focusing on instead of AA-1.
