Dear Chairman and Commissioners:

My name is Kristina Stroud, and I am a homeowner within the Anaqua Springs Ranch development that is located off of Toutant Beauregard. I had planned to provide an oral argument during the conference call as stated in the letter issued by the PUC in September. However, a couple of days before the date of the conference call, I received notice that the conference call was in fact an in person meeting to be held in Austin. Due to the short notice, I was not able to coordinate mine and/or my husband's work schedules in order for either of us to attend the meeting. This does not mean that we do not care about this project and the final outcome. We wanted the opportunity to voice our concerns to the Chairman and Commissioners. It is our hope that the Chairman and Commissioners will take our plea into consideration as written below.

As a future mother, I am deeply concerned with the lack of care and consideration that has been given to the current and future children that will be attending Dr. Sara McAndrew Elementary. Route Z2 would put a segment within 280 feet of the elementary school. It has also been stated on the record that Northside ISD will be building a new middle school next to the elementary school. The possible health effects and concerns associated with high voltage transmission towers are very strong reasons to avoid utilizing route Z2. It was startling to listen to CPS Energy lawyers during the proceedings give so little disregard to the possible health

risks to these children. I understand that it is your job to give an unbiased decision to the betterment of as many people as possible, but as a future mother, I find it very disturbing that little care was given to the effects that Route Z2 could have on the children that attend the elementary school and will attend the future middle school.

Please, do not put high voltage transmission towers near my children's elementary and middle schools. Choose a route that won't have possible negative consequences on my children.
