Serene and Scenic Hills is one of the oldest neighborhoods in the area. We're a neighborhood of middle class families, veterans, teachers, and first responders. We don't have the means or funding to retain representation in this matter, all we have is our voice.

Running large lines and building a substation next to our neighborhood, or along Toutant Beauregard, will detrimentally impact many homeowners and put high voltage lines adjacent to McAndrew Elementary School. This route and plan seems to maximize the number of people negatively impacted by this project and would no-doubt open the Public Utility Commission up to questions about their decision making process. Given that CPS has stated that this route would place poles outside the road easement it seems obvious that it would run lines over driveways and front yards while other routes could be adjacent to larger rural properties. The decision to go forward with this plan would beg questions of fairness and propriety when compared to other routes.

Minimizing detrimental impact to the public should be an obvious goal of a Public Utility Commission. It's my hope that Serene and Scenic Hills Estates will not be made to bear the brunt of this growth and that the commission can find a way to place the substation and lines where it will not change our community for the worse.
