## COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS, PROPOSED NOTICE, AND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 1, files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness, Proposed Notice, and Procedural Schedule. Staff recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On July 7, 2020, Tall Pines Utility, Inc. (Tall Pines) and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County. CSWR seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer Tall Pines' water service area held under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11003. The requested area includes approximately 42 acres and 73 connections.

On July 16, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 1, establishing a deadline of August 17, 2020, for Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and to file a recommendation regarding how to proceed with the application and to propose a procedural schedule. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

### II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Jolie Mathis, Infrastructure Division, recommends that it be found administratively complete and accepted for filing. Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness is not a comment on the merits of the application, but only that it is complete for further processing.

### III. NOTICE

At this time, Staff recommends that the Applicants proceed with providing public notice to all current customers, persons, political subdivisions, and other entities listed in the attached memorandum using the notice provided by Ms. Mathis. Along with each individual notice, Staff recommends that Applicants provide an accurate map delineating the requested service area.

Within 30 days of the provision of notice, Staff recommends that the Applicants file proof of notice as described in the attached memorandum. Finally, Staff recommends that the Applicants use the attached notices and affidavits to meet these requirements.

### IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the application be found administratively complete. Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	October 1, 2020
Deadline to intervene	Thirty (30) days after notice is issued

### V. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully recommends that the application be found administratively complete, that the Applicants be directed to provide notice as detailed in the attached memorandum, and that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted.

On July 7, 2020, CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC (Purchaser) and the Tall Pines Utility, Inc. (Seller) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for Sale, Transfer, or Merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County, Texas, pursuant to Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239.

Specifically, CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC, Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13290, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of Tall Pines Utility, Inc.'s water CCN No(s). 11003. The requested area includes approximately 42 acres and 73 connections.

Staff from the Rate Regulation Division and Infrastructure Division have reviewed the information filed by the Applicant and recommend that the application be deemed administratively complete. Staff further recommends the Applicant be ordered to do the following:

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
