**ORDER NO. 5
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Quadvest L.P. On December 4, 2020, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the notice provided.

On November 19, 2020, Quadvest the affidavit of Yvette McNellie, partner at Quadvest, attesting that notice was provided to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on November 11, 2020. Quadvest's November 19, 2020 filing also included a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in the *Jackson County Herald Tribune*, a newspaper of general circulation in Jackson County, on October 28 and November 4, 2020.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Deadline to Intervene	December 11, 2020
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Quadvest for review and consent	February 24, 2021
Deadline for Quadvest to file signed consent forms with the Commission	March 3, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	March 10, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	March 17, 2021
