COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 10, 2020, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest), filed an application to discontinue water service and cancel its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11612 in Jackson County, Texas. The requested service area to be decertified consists of 152 acres and no current customers.

On July 15, 2020, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 2, requiring Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and propose a procedural schedule on or before August 10, 2020. Therefore, this pleading timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs additional time to prepare its recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice, and to propose a procedural schedule. As such, Staff requests that the deadline to file its recommendation be extended to August 24, 2020.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ extend the deadline to file comments on the administrative completeness and proposed notice, and to propose a procedural schedule, to August 24, 2020.
