ORDER NO. 6 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the July 13, 2020, petition of FCS Lancaster, Ltd. to amend Rockett Special Utility District's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Dallas County by streamlined expedited release, and the sufficiency of the petition and notice.

On November 18, 2020, Commission Staff filed its recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the petition and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete and notice sufficient.

Under the provisions of Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, if streamlined expedited release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
