ORDER NO. 6 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice filed by Jones-Owen Company dba South Silver Creek I, II, and III and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC and amends the procedural schedule established in Order No. 5 of the present docket.

On September 23 and 24, 2020, CSWR-Texas filed an affidavit attesting to the provision of notice to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on September 21, 2020. CSWR-Texas also filed a copy of the notice and maps sent. On September 30, 2020, CSWR-Texas filed a representative copy of the notice that was provided. On October 1, 2020, CSWR-Texas filed an affidavit attesting to proof of notice to Lower Colorado River Authority and the Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District. On October 1, 2020, Commission Staff recommended that the notice be found sufficient and that the procedural schedule be amended to allow an intervention period of 30 days from the date of the applicant's corrected notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and amends procedural schedule as follows:

admit evidence and proposed order approving	
sale and allowing transaction to proceed.	
120-day deadline for the Commission to	January 19, 2021
approve the sale or require a hearing
