**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT, DIRECTING NOTICE BE REISSUED,
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND RESTYLING**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Perrin Water Systems, Inc. and Patterson Water Supply, LLC. On September 16, 2020, applicants filed the affidavit of Mark Patterson, president of Patterson Water Supply, attesting that notice of the application was provided to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on August 18, 2020.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice deficient. Specifically, applicants' proof of notice does not indicate whether an attached map was included as was required by Order No. 2. Accordingly, applicants are directed to either provide proof of inclusion of the required map in applicant's August 18, 2020 notice, or applicants will reissue notice with the required map to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties in the manner described in Jolie Mathis' memorandum of August 13, 2020, using the included forms.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for applicants' to reissue notice to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties, if no map attached	October 5, 2020
Deadline for applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that reissued notice was provided, along with a copy of the notice and map sent	October 8, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of reissued notice	October 15, 2020
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
