FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Perrin Water Systems, Inc. and Patterson Water Supply, LLC. On October 1, 2020, applicants filed the affidavit of Mark Patterson, president of Patterson Water Supply, attesting that notice of the application was provided to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on August 18, 2020. Applicants filed a copy of the notice and map that were provided to all affected parties.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Notice completed	August 18, 2020
Deadline to intervene or request a hearing on the merits	September 17, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment	November 16, 2020
Deadline for applicants to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale	November 30, 2020
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	December 8, 2020
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	December 16, 2020 ¹

¹ Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(a) and (j), 120 days after August 18, 2020 is December 16, 2020.
