### COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On July 14, 2020, Patterson Water Supply Corporation (Patterson) and Perrin Water Systems, Inc. (Perrin) (collectively, the Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Jack County. Patterson seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of Perrin's service area under Perrin's water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) number 12196 to Patterson's water CCN number 13248. The requested area includes approximately 163 acres and 129 connections.

On February 1, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 7, requiring Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs, if applicable, to the Applicants for review and consent by March 1, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

### I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time for a determination to be made as to the approval of the sale of the Danieldale Community Water Service and Rocky Point Community water systems from Community Water Service, Inc. to Patterson in Docket 49931<sup>1</sup> in order to provide a tariff in this docket.

Furthermore, on February 12, 2021, Texas Governor Greg Abbott issued a disaster declaration under Section 418.014 of the Texas Government Code related to severe winter weather. The conditions giving rise to this disaster declaration resulted in power and internet outages throughout the State of Texas, including Staff's limited access to power and Internet service.

Consequently, Staff respectfully requests that its deadline to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to the Applicants for review and consent be extended to March 31, 2021.

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ extend the deadline to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs, if applicable, to the Applicants for review and consent to March 31, 2021.
