#### ORDER NO. 2 GRANTING ABATEMENT AND REVISING DEADLINE

This Order addresses the Commission Staff's July 28, 2020 request for abatement and extension. CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC filed multiple applications with the Commission for the sale, transfer, or merger of existing facilities and service areas under a new, currently unassigned, water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN), beginning with Docket Nos. 50251,<sup>1</sup> 50276,<sup>2</sup> or 50311,<sup>3</sup> filed in late 2019.

Commission Staff requests the abatement of this proceeding pending orders finding the applications in Docket Nos. 50989,<sup>4</sup> 51003,<sup>5</sup> 51026,<sup>6</sup> and 51031<sup>7</sup> administratively complete.<sup>8</sup>

#### Order No. 2

Commission Staff contends that abatement of this proceeding will help to ensure that Commission Staff can review each docket and accurately prepare the corresponding CCN map.

On July 29, 2020, CSWR-Texas filed its response opposing Commission Staff's request for abatement. As an alternative, CSWR-Texas requested that Staff be granted an extension to file its recommendation, but be directed to file its recommendation as soon as possible after issuance of an order in Docket No. 50251, 50276, or 50311.

In light of Order No. 2 filed on July 29, 2020, in Docket No. 51026 and after considering the arguments presented, the administrative law judge grants Commission Staff's request to abate, but to the extent consistent with Order No. 2 in Docket No. 51026. Accordingly, Commission Staff must file its recommendation on the sufficiency of the instant application and propose a procedural schedule in this docket, if appropriate, no later than 14 days after an order approving the sale, transfer, or merger to proceed and be consummated in either Docket Nos. 50251, 50276, or 50311 is filed.
