ALLOWING RESPONSES AND DENYING ATTORNEY'S FEES

This Order addresses the July 20, 2020 complaint filed by Rio Ancho Homeowners Association and David and Doreen Meyers (collectively Rio Ancho) against Aqua Texas, Inc. regarding water service.

On August 19, 2020, Commission Staff filed a statement on position recommending that the following parties be dismissed for failure to comply with the Commission's informal-complaint process: Rio Ancho HOA; Ashlie Cobb; Casey Cobb; Rob Myers; and Eric Robinson. Further, Commission Staff recommended that that the parties' request for attorney's fees be denied, as relief that cannot be granted.

On or before September 9, 2020, the parties may respond to Commission Staff's recommendation to dismiss the above parties.

The administrative law judge denies the request for attorney's fees.

Additionally, Commission Staff requested that this case be referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing on the merits, as there are substantial facts that are in dispute and an evidentiary record needs to be developed. Referral to SOAH will be addressed in a future order.
