COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 4, files this Recommendation on Final Disposition. Staff recommends that the petition be approved. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 24, 2020, Imperial Heights, Ltd. (Imperial Heights) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release of a 36.4-acre tract of land within the boundaries of Aqua Texas Inc.'s (Aqua Texas) water Certificate of Convenience Number (CCN) 13203 and sewer CCN No. 21065, in Harris County, under Texas Water Code § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Imperial Heights asserts that the tract of land is at least 25 acres, is not receiving water or sewer service, and is in Harris County, which is a qualifying county.

On August 21, 2020, Aqua Texas filed a motion to intervene in this proceeding. On August 31, 2020, Order No. 2 was issued, granting the motion to intervene. Order No. 2 also found the petition administratively complete and established a deadline of September 25, 2020 for Staff to file its recommendation on final disposition. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STATUTORY APPROVAL DEADLINE

Under TWC § 13.2541(c), the Commission shall grant the petition for streamlined expedited release not later than the 60th day after the date the landowner files the petition. A petition is not considered filed until it is deemed administratively complete. Imperial Heights's

petition was deemed administratively complete in Order No. 2, issued August 31, 2020. Therefore, the 60-day deadline for administrative approval is October 30, 2020.

III. FINAL RECOMMENDATION

As supported by the attached memorandum from Patricia Garcia, Infrastructure Division, Staff recommends that the petition be approved. Staff recommends that Imperial Heights's petition satisfies the requirements of TWC § 13.2541(b) and 16 TAC § 24.245(h). Specifically, the petition demonstrates that the property which Imperial Heights seeks streamlined expedited release is located in a qualifying county (Harris County), is at least 25 acres in size, is not receiving water or sewer service, and is at least partially located in the Aqua Texas's water and sewer-certificated service area. In addition, Imperial Heights has provided deeds confirming its ownership of the property.

Accordingly, Staff recommends that Imperial Heights's petition for streamlined expedited release be approved. The final water and sewer CCN maps are attached to this filing. Staff additionally recommends that the final maps and certificate be provided to Aqua Texas and that Aqua Texas file a certified copy of the CCN maps and a boundary description of the CCN service areas in the Harris County Clerk's office, as required under TWC § 13.257(r)-(s).

IV. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that Imperial Heights's petition be approved and that an order be issued consistent with the foregoing recommendations.

Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Harris County by Expedited Release

On July 24, 2020, Imperial Heights, Ltd. (Imperial Heights or Petitioner) filed a petition for expedited release from Aqua Texas Inc.'s (Aqua Texas) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13203 and sewer CCN No. 21065 in Harris County, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). The Petitioner asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Harris County which is a qualifying county.

The Petitioner submitted a sworn affidavit attesting that the property is not receiving water or sewer service from Aqua Texas and a warranty deed confirming the Petitioner's ownership of the tract of land. In addition, the Petitioner submitted sufficient maps and digital data for determining the location of the requested release area within Aqua Texas's certificated service area. Mapping Staff was able to confirm the total property is approximately 37.8 acres. The requested area to be released from CCN Nos. 13203 and 21065 is approximately 36.4 acres.

On August 21, 2020, Aqua Texas requested to intervene. On August 31, 2020, the Administrative Law Judge granted Aqua Texas's motion to intervene. Aqua Texas has an 8" water line and a 4" sewer force main that run through the outer edges of the area being requested for expedited release. The water line and sewer force main are inside the property requested for expedited release but do not appear to be serving the area only running through it.

In accordance with TWC § 13.2541 and 16 TAC § 24.245(h), the Petitioners have met the Commission's requirements to allow for the release of the requested area from Aqua Texas's CCN Nos. 13203 and 21065. Therefore, Staff recommends approval of the petition. Enclosed is a final map and certificate for Commission approval.

Additionally, Staff recommends that a final map and certificate be provided to the CCN holder. Pursuant to TWC §§ 13.257 (r)-(s), Staff further recommends that Aqua Texas file the following information in the Harris County Clerk's office: (1) a certified copy of the CCN map; (2) a certified copy of the amended certificate; and (3) a boundary description of the CCN service area.






