**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of the City of Pharr and the City of San Juan filed on July 29, 2020, for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend sewer certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Hidalgo County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Commission Staff requested that Pharr and San Juan supplement their application by October 28, 2020. The ALJ notes that the applicants made a supplemental filing on October 15, 2020, which may cure the deficiencies of the application.

On or before November 13, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
